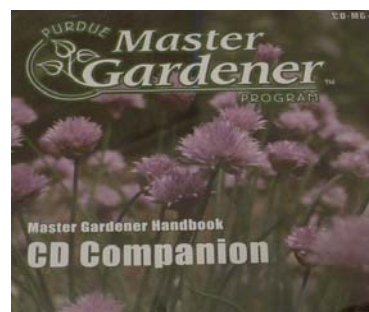

The Purdue Master Gardener Handbook CD Companion includes 200+ publications (pdf format) on topics from indoor plant care to pests in tomatoes. A great reference!

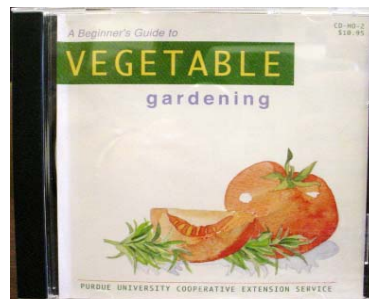


A Beginner's Guide to Vegetable Gardening

Whether you're a new gardener or a veteran looking for a refresher course, this interactive CD-ROM is the ideal reference for you.

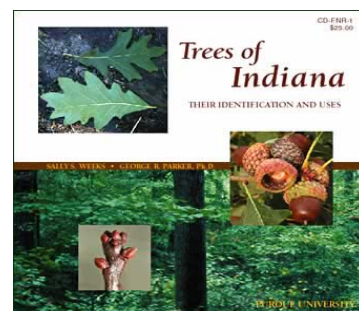
