He has written four books and over 200 research papers and documents, and has delivered over 3000 presentations. His latest book is "Virginia Claypool Meredith: Queen of American Agriculture". Fred is an energetic speaker and makes the topic of pesticides very interesting with his interactive presentation.

Garden Club of Indiana's own past president, Ruth Moorhead and her husband, Phil, are going to be telling us all about gourds, how to grow them and what to do with them.
