

Driving Directions to Orange County Community Center

The Orange County Community Center is located at the Orange County Fairgrounds at the north end of Paoli, IN, which is located on IN Highway 37, south of Bedford. Once you have arrived in Paoli, you will proceed on Highway 37 until you reach the Walmart store from the south, or the Hoosier Hills Credit Union from the north. Turn west on Hospital Road (PDQ Rental is on the corner) and proceed to next stop sign. The Community Center will be ahead of you on the right.

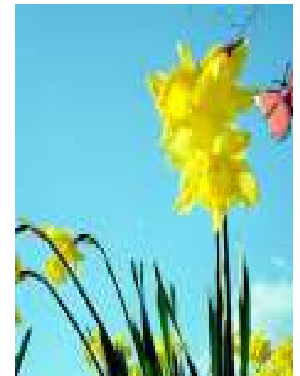
One word of caution. If you are coming from the south, Highway 37 has been renumbered at the junction with I-64, to Highway 237.
