On the selling floor will be booths offering, among other things, unique garden sculpture, fountains, and arbors; new plants; tours of gardens around the world; the very latest in garden tools; beautiful garden pottery; water gardens and water gardening; information on controlling pests; superior soil amendments; and, even good dirt! Master Gardener groups and horticultural societies (e.g. American Daffodil Society, Bonsai Society of Greater Cincinnati, and Greater Cincinnati Wild Ones) will be on hand to inform and amaze you with their programs and enthusiasm for these special topics.
