Many ornamental bamboo species


Turf

Temperate lawn grasses are not adaptable Many tropical grasses are coarse resemble crabgrass.


Flowering shrubs and vines


A wide variety of shrubby plants and vines Many of our indoor plants are landscape plants in the tropics















Note two types of palms: single trunk = date palm, bifurcated trunk = doum palm.
